ABES RECEIVES COMMITTEE OF THE INTERNATIONAL WATER ASSOCIATION – IWA

The Brazilian Association of Sanitary and Environmental Engineering - ABES received in São Paulo, between the 25th and 27th of July, a high-level delegation from the IWA - International Water Association, composed by Kalanithy Vairavamoorthy, Eecutive Director, Kizito Masinde, Director of Events and Awards, and Daniela Bemfica, Director of Strategic Programs and Commitment.

Among the various topics covered, sponge cities, construction and financing for implementation and examples of countries that have adopted this solution, such as China, were addressed. Interest was shown in bringing the city of São Paulo closer to the IWA and the capital of São Paulo was made available for future initiatives by the associations.



AIDIS AT THE ARGENTINE COUNCIL OF INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

Eng. José Luis Inglese, President of AIDIS Interamericana, was invited to an academic session organized by the Committee on Environmental Studies and Human Development of the Argentine Council of International Relations.

VALUE INNOVATION AWARD IN BRAZIL

Companhia de Saneamento do Paraná (Sanepar) was awarded, for the third consecutive time, as the most innovative company in the infrastructure sector in Brazil by the 2023 Brazil Innovation Value Award, the ability to generate knowledge and the strategic application of new technologies.

This year, 995 cases of innovation from 253 companies were evaluated. This is the ninth edition of the award, which evaluates around 1,000 cases a year.



NEW AIDIS STANDARDS DIVISION

At AIDIS, the Norms Division - DINOSA - was created and a group formed to participate in the development of the ISO 24.500 series "Management of Water Supply, Sewage and Rainfall Services", together with the Working Groups of the Technical Committee 224 (ISO /TC224).

The objective is to support and promote, through the AIDIS Chapters, the adoption of ISO standards in companies and organizations.

Currently, more than 15 countries in Latin America and the Caribbean participate.

WORLD WATER WEEK IN STOCKHOLM, SWEDEN

World Water Week is the main global conference, held every year since 1991. It attracts a diverse mix of participants from diverse professional backgrounds and from all corners of the world. This year it will take place from the 20th to the 24th of August at the Waterfront Congress Center in Stockholm. There will be sessions on topics selected by SIWI but convened by leading organizations from around the world; scientific seminars; "Accelerators", which is a training program carried out in conjunction with partner organizations and award ceremonies, from the most prestigious in the world, the Stockholm Water Prize, attended by royalty and the Stockholm Junior Water Prize International Competition, for young students representing their countries.



XXV CHILEAN CONGRESS OF SANITARY AND ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING

At the request of members and congressmen, the deadline for delivering technical papers was extended to March 1st of this year. The XXV Chilean Sanitary Congress of and Environmental Engineering, which will be held at the Hotel Dreams in Coyhaigue from November 20th to 22nd, represents an unbeatable opportunity to learn about and disseminate studies and experiences carried out in the health sector and in the industrial sector related to the use of water, the waste generated and its subsequent return to the environment, in addition to discussing the country's needs on the subject and disseminating current technological trends.
